The Tally Ho Theatre in Leesburg will be up and running again Jan. 11. David Wright, David Sly and Steve Heaton of Market St. Productions are the proud new lessees of the historic theater, which originally opened in 1931.

"They were the perfect fit because they have a lot of experience in the performing arts," Tally Ho owner Don Devine said.

The trio is part of an improv troupe called Last Ham Standing, which Wright says is very similar in tone to "Whose Line Is It Anyway?"

The new operators plan to feature a combination of first-run movies, live performances and classic movies like "The Rocky Horror Picture Show."
